Nov 9th @ 5:30 pm Cost: \$25

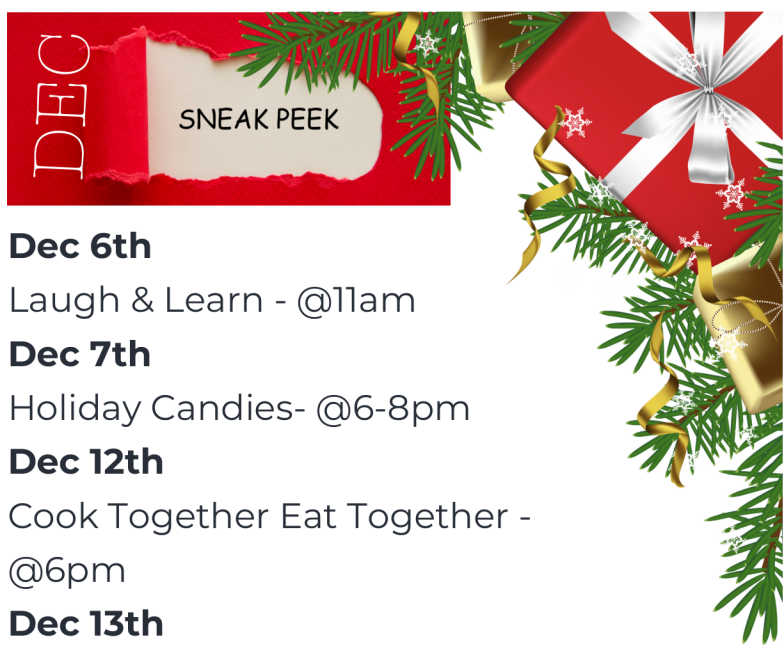
